

The Hallen School Code of Conduct Summarized

Below are expectations of student behavior. Please reference the complete version, as it further explains and expands upon this following summary.

Students have a right to expect:

- An education that will maximize their potential
- Courteous and respectful treatment by all Hallen School staff
- The opportunity to be heard when disciplinary action might be taken
- A safe and supportive environment
- Freedom from violence, threats, intimidation and theft

To help ensure the above students may not:

- Use personal cell phones or any electronic communication device during school time without permission;
- Wear clothing that is offensive, vulgar or disrupts the educational process;
- Use school computers, fax machines phones or other equipment without permission;
- Smoke;
- Gamble;
- Curse or use foul gestures;
- Put hands on other students or staff;
- Engage in or cause disruptive (unsafe) behavior in school or on the school bus;
- Use racial, ethnic, or any slur that targets religion, appearance, gender identity, sexual orientation or disability;
- Steal;
- Cause vandalism of any nature i.e. graffiti, or any damage to school environs or property;
- Possess or share (by internet or in person) photos depicting violence or pornography;
- Fight;
- Threaten violence;
- Bully – cyber or in person;
- Possess or use alcohol or drugs of any kind or;
- Possess any weapon including, but not limited to, guns and knives of any size.
